What went well, what went wrong?

Problems in society and in future society, which students will have to deal with

Students were interested in all national groups. The tasks made it easy to start working on the topic. It was good for the students to think outside of their own comfort zone.

Students came up with some common problems like youth unemployment, environment, health (and health care) topics. Additionally the national groups had some "individual" problems: bullying, data protection, family structure, internships, ...

Situation of young people in the different countries.

All groups agreed that it was very interesting to compare the situation in the different European countries. The discussion in Bad Tölz showed that the students could relate to the problems of their European peers.

Personal strategies for students to deal with the problems of young people in their country (no film but power-point-presentation or poster,...)

All students' groups came up with some personal strategies. Concerning the problem of unemployment they all pointed out that to be well educated is essential. The task was interesting because they are all affected.

Letters to the students' MEP

Not all of the groups got an answer to their letters yet. We agreed to summarize the answers and to send the questions and answers to Andreas for the publication on the website. This could be the base for the last steps in the project dealing with the political solutions of the problems of young people in Europe. We try to have a discussion in our facebook group on this.

Work on the students' position towards their national governments' points of view

In most of the groups the discussion of the problems included their national governments points of view.
