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I. Presentation of the national school systems

III. Entrepreneurial learning

Marie Kniest (K&R Education Malmö AB) presented the concept of entrepreneurial learning in Sweden. Entrepreneurial learning in the narrow sense means dealing with entrepreneurship, making the students aware of entrepreneurship and making the students fit for being an entrepreneur, In the broad sense entrepreneurial learning deals with the competences young people should have to play a responsible and successful part in European society and economy. There are strong links between the setting of the 8 key competences, education in the EU should deal with (according to the educational programs of the EU) and the concept of entrepreneurial learning.
